Overview

IEC Technical Committee (TC) 86—which prepares standards for fiber-optic systems, modules, devices and components—includes three main subcommittees: SC 86A (Fibers and Cables), SC 86B (Interconnecting Devices and Passive Components) and SC 86C (Systems and Active Devices). Industry standards for optical fiber cables, components, systems and applications continually evolve and progress in an effort to ensure interoperability, performance, uniform testing and support for the latest technologies, bandwidth demand and industry initiatives. As the industry evolves, Active Optical Cables (AOC) are widely used in HPCs and have more recently become popular in hyperscale, enterprise and storage systems as a high-speed, plug & play solution with longer reaches than Direct Attach Copper (DAC) cables.
