Overview

Safely install a double gang electrical box. This guide covers selecting the correct size and type for both new and existing walls. Connecting two electrical boxes together is a relatively simple job, but there are some important steps that must be taken to ensure it's done safely and correctly. It takes the incoming power and safely distributes it to different circuits throughout your building. Is it permissible to run 2 separate feeders from the meter base without first installing overcurrent protection at the meter base?

And if so, do I need to size each feeder for each 200amp panel. This guide focuses on the double gang box, used when two separate electrical devices need to be installed adjacent to each other in a single wall opening. 1 service feeding 2

Yes generally you can have 2 to 6 service disconnects, in separate enclosures, each fed with their own service conductors. They generally would need to be grouped in one location.

How close together can two 1-gang boxes be installed?

There's no limit on how close they can be as long as they can still be installed per manufacturer's instructions. A 7/8" board is massive...yes you can use that to support multiple boxes.
