

How to replace the IP address of a core switch

Go to SYSTEM > System Info > System IP, and configure the IP address of the switch.

» Using the CLI Follow these command lines to change the IP address:
Switch#configure Switch (config)#interface vlan 1 Switch (config-if)#ip address. The switch can have multiple IP addresses. Each IP address can be assigned to specified interfaces or ports, Link Aggregation Groups (LAGs), or Virtual Local Area Networks (VLANs). This allows you to easily configure. In factory default setting, all the ports belong to VLAN 1, so you can access the switch using the IP address of VLAN 1, which is 192. Exact commands and menus may vary by vendor and model, so refer to the switch manual or vendor configuration guide for device-specific details.
