

How to safely inspect a distribution box



Overview

Make it a habit to inspect distribution boxes at least once a month visually. Look for loose, corroded, or damaged connections, dirt buildup, or other issues. Wires should be neatly organized and secure. Check that the lug nuts are. A septic distribution box, often called a D-box, is a small, buried container that acts as a junction point between the septic tank and the soil absorption area. The D-box then channels the effluent. Verify that the box is securely mounted and that there are no loose connections. Inspect circuit breakers for proper operation.
