Solid Green: The ONT is powered on and functioning normally. Make sure all cables are securely connected. For help with a WiFi 7 Aginet router go here. If no lights are illuminated on your fiber router it's likely not powered on: Confirm that the power cord is securely connected from the Power port on the back of the router. An Ethernet cable running from the fiber terminal should be plugged into the LAN/WAN port on the back of the C4000XG.
