This unexpected noise can be due to degraded wiring, overloaded circuits, or even poor installation. The sudden, abrupt sound of an electrical "pop" followed by a dead outlet or a tripped breaker is a definitive sign of a problem within your home's electrical system. When they start tripping, overheating, or making strange noises, it's more than just an inconvenience - it's your home's cry for help. While some cases are relatively minor, others indicate serious fire or shock. The key factor in solving the problem in the long run and finding an adequate solution is detecting the core issue. So, you should start by checking your wall sockets. The sound can occur because of a poor installation that allowed the wire to come together, a bad socket, a living thing entering the socket, or excess moisture in the socket. Next, grab a screwdriver and carefully pull out.
